WHY LEADERSHIP TRAINING?

The ACC Strategic Plan, Vision 2019, lists 7 Priorities, beginning with "Develop leadership education for mission, evangelism, and ministry." ARM has been meeting this need for 16 years by providing leadership training to strengthen clergy and lay leaders to minister more effectively in the power of the Holy Spirit.

The mission of Anglican Renewal Ministries is to help people discover the fullness of their life in Jesus, in which they experience the release of the Holy Spirit and his gifts for ministry.

The goal of ARM Schools of Renewal Ministry is to equip Christians as leaders so that clergy and lay leaders become teams to prayerfully lead parishes into renewal and grow in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. These leaders should also be available to assist other parishes to move into renewal.

WHO SHOULD COME?

This is a training event especially designed for Anglican clergy, to assist them in their calling to renew the local, regional, diocesan and national church. It also targets those who provide Christian leadership in other ministries **and thus is open to all Christian churches.** All participants should believe that they are called to bring the renewing power and presence of the Holy Spirit to Christ's church and His world.

COURSE FEES

The fee is \$650 before October 1, 2011, \$750 afterwards. This fee includes lodging, meals, and program material. A deposit of \$100 must accompany each request for registration. Deposits will not be refunded after Oct 1, 2011.

Participants stay at St. Michael's Retreat in Lumsden, Saskatchewan, overlooking the beautiful Qu'Appelle valley (306-731-3316, www.stmichaelsretreat.ca). Most rooms are single occupancy. Childcare is not available.
